In 2007 the university merged with HHC Business School Centre. These figures do not include more than 1000 foreign students and exchange students. The university has a staff of approximately 3000 full-time equivalents. The Bachelor's Programme in Danish with a Minor in Classical Studies, Latin

The graduate has acquired a number of broad competences within the field of the humanities. He or she is able to delimit a topic and analyse it deploying relevant theories and methods, while systematizing and critically evaluating the knowledge and data relevant to the task. Particular significance is attributed to the graduate's ability, both orally and in writing, to communicate scholarly material in a manner that makes it relevant and comprehensible to various target-groups. The graduate has, furthermore, been trained to participate in cooperative activities and to both offer and receive constructive criticism.

Minor in Classical Studies Latin, Language

Bachelor graduates are trained in the analysis of certain areas within the literary and cultural output of the Roman world, as well as its social and historical context and the classical tradition in Europe and the modern World. The degree provides insight and some experience in working with ancient languages (Latin and Ancient Greek), in working with a chronologically distant culture as well as an introduction to translation theory and literary genres. The bachelor graduate is able to analyse cultural artefacts and has a general knowledge of topography.

Furthermore, the degree provides insight into the relation between myth and history, religious and philosophical methods of thinking, as well as both practical and theoretical rhetoric and also the ability to understand and interpret complex historical connections.

The BA also provides tools for problem-solving in educational and cultural institutions as well as editorial and administrative jobs in the private sector.

Major in Danish

BA graduates possess broad core competences in the subject both in the communication of Danish cultural history, in particular literary history, and in analytical and theoretical work with the Danish language in aesthetic texts as well as those for everyday use. BA graduates can, therefore, both undertake tasks related to research and work in all areas relating to communication. The skills acquired by BA graduates can, in conjunction with an Option, constitute a degree directed towards immediate application in business in the contexts specified. The BA graduate's competences are based on their knowledge of the Danish language and literature in a Nordic and global context and of the Danish media. They also include, however, a critical ability to reflect that can be applied in the context of other subject areas and communicative processes.
